Plan to Monitor COVID-19 Risks: Melodies in Nature

A full COVID-19 Safety Plan has been developed by SDC in accordance with WorkSafeBC BC and can be found on our website at sdcprograms.org.

Social Distancing

- Participants are situated 2 metres apart from each other and the SDC staff present will monitor the location of all individuals during the program.
 - Hula Hoops are used to ensure participants cannot physically come into contact with one another.
 - Volunteers directly work with 1-2 participants but will remain a safe distance away from the participants.
- At 15-minute intervals, SDC staff will do a head count of all participants to ensure that no youth have left the premises and the total number of people at the program location is under fifty.
- No individuals not involved in the SDC program will be allowed on the premises of Melodies in Nature.

Personal Protective Equipment

- Ensure all participants, SDC staff and volunteers are properly wearing personal protective equipment at the beginning of each session.
 - This includes face masks/face shields

Health and Personal Hygiene

- Educate participants, volunteers and SDC staff on the key elements of preventing the spread of COVID-19
- Have hand sanitizer available and encourage individuals in the program to wash their hands before and after the program
- Prevent the sharing of any objects during the duration of the program
 - Participants/volunteers will all have their own instruments and should not be in contact with others' possessions.



Cleaning and Sanitation

- All items that have been in contact with will be sanitized using disinfecting wipes after use during the program.
- SDC staff are responsible for ensuring the program premises are cleaned after the program and returned to its original appearance.

Sickness

- If any people on site of the programs show signs of sickness, they will be asked to leave the site immediately.
- After the affected individual has left the premises, SDC will phone and check up on the state of said individual.
 - If the individual had tested positive for COVID-19, all people present at that day's program session will be notified immediately and action will be taken in the best interest of everyone's safety.
